1. Must be a Filipino citizen
2. A permanent employee of the Department of Education as a teacher, principal, supervisor or an educator in the formal and non-formal basic education Alternative Learning System of the department
3. Actively teaching/working in the Philippines for the last 5 years
4. With a valid PRC license.
5. With average teaching performance/work performance rating of "very satisfactory" in the last 3 years.
6. Have at least a Bachelor's degree.

There will be 10 finalists to be chosen from the pool of nominees. A panel of judges from Marylindbert Int'l and the Department of Education will conduct an actual evaluation of the finalists. Visits in the schools and community of the finalists will be conducted to choose the 5 Gintong Parangal ni Amb. Antonio Cabangon Chua.
